### Welcome to our Autumn Newsletter



We have found that a high percentage of the cats we have taken into care have needed neutering and there have been health issues, but I am very pleased to say it has been manageable. 

Needless to say, the lady who reported the group to us got quite attached and mum was spayed, blood tested and returned to her. I'm positive there will be more cooked chicken for mum from now on.

The five kittens have all been homed now and their fosterer is missing them terribly! Don't worry Cheryll, there will be more for you to look after I'm sure.

When Angelica came to us, we suspected she may be pregnant. Time proved otherwise. She is a beautiful young lady aged around 2-3 years. She loves to be the centre of attention and is very playful, however, she can get over excited at times, so we are looked for a home without young children. ### Scanning

In August our scanning team was called out to scan 10 cats to see if they were microchipped.

Three of the cats were chipped and reunited with their owners.

Four cats were unchipped. One has been brought into our care and another is now on our waiting list. The other two cats have been kept by the people reporting them to us.

Unfortunately, the other three cats were dead. One as the result of a car accident. The cat was chipped and although it was very sad we were able to let its owner know what had happened. The two others were kittens found dead together by the roadside, neither was chipped.

The Scanning Team are a vital part of A Purrfect Friend. We do try to go out to every cat that is reported as a stray to us. It helps us and more importantly the cats in a number of different ways. Obviously, if we can get out and scan a cat and it is microchipped, they can be very quickly reunited with their owner or sometimes the owner does not want or is unable to have their cat back and we can organise it to be brought into our care with their consent. Scanning prevents wasted vets appointments. It is also an opportunity for us to assess the cats for their temperament and to ascertain if they have any urgent medical issues.

If you need someone to scan a cat you believe to be a stray please contact <u>apurrfectfriend@gmail.com</u> (we do not charge for this service), alternatively, if you are able to take them, any vet will be able to check for a microchip free of charge.
