A Purrfect Friend - Financial Review for 6 months to December 2022

Following a successful year of fundraising and rehoming to June 2022, the last 6 months ending December 2022 have continued in the same vein. In summary the key results are as follows: -

The income generated so far this year is up £4k compared to the prior year with events this year continuing to be particularly successful. We are still greatly dependent on donations from all our kind supporters as adoption fees do not cover the costs we incur in ensuring the cats are fit and healthy for rehoming.

We are now regularly claiming Gift Aid from HMRC and have been registered for VAT since July 22 which means we can reclaim VAT on our vet fees and other vatable expenses.

The Trustees would like to thank all our supporters for their continued generosity and a huge thank you to all our fosterers whose volunteering has enabled us to rehome 61 cats so far this year

Tallulah has kept his brother and Otis's mum has gone to the person who originally notified us of her plight. Otis has now been homed and renamed Star.

Isabelle's pen was home to Ginge who now has a new home and a new name, Solomon.

Pringles pen is currently occupied by Banjo, a very handsome boy, patiently waiting for his new home.

Lucy's pen is with Louise and for several weeks the residents have been Millie and her 5 kittens. Millie is also lucky enough to have been offered a home by the lady who made us aware of her situation and the kittens all have new homes to go to.

Marybeth and Marybeth 1's pens are both at Deborah's. Marybeth's pen had been Bella's home from 11th June until 28th December! Our longest stay cat has a new home at last. Nala, a 6 month-old little girl is in the other pen but we intend to move her to an outdoor home as soon as the weather improves. She is super friendly, but unfortunately her inappropriate toileting is an issue that we have been unable to resolve.

Shadrack's pen is with Emma and her foster cat Storm (Emma calls him Mischief) has waited for a new home for several weeks, but he too has found his forever home.

Becks pen; Cheryll and her family have looked after a litter of 4 kittens, all of whom have been homed and they currently have Sooty and Sweep. It's interesting that we have had so many kittens at this time of year and please be assured we consider very carefully when they can go to their new homes.

For anyone that may be feeding a stray cat (or trying their best not to feed it as you think the cat may have a home), please feel free to get in touch as we have several volunteers who have micro-chip scanners who may be able to come out to scan the cat. Please consider how great it would be to re-unite the cat with its owner, especially if he or she has been missing for weeks, months or even years. Cats cannot tell us where they have been or how they came to be outside your home. I have heard people say the cat has left home for a reason, it has been abandoned, the owners don't deserve the cat, all sorts of supposition. In many cases, we just don't know, but if the cat is chipped, we can get a long way down the line to finding out some history and hopefully re-uniting he or she with their family.



Pets at home have included A Purrfect Friend on their lifelines scheme. It's huge for us, the scheme is very generous to charities. If you would like or already have nominated a charity for the lifelines scheme, you can now change your affiliation to A Purrfect Friend. To do it, go on the PAH website, select Your lifelines and the option should come up to support a local or a national charity. Click on local. Our charity is listed under the Preston Store, so if your card is registered to any other PAH, for example Capital Centre, please change that to Preston and you will see our charity at the top of the drop down list. It will now make any difference to yourself which your local store is down as, but it will be a huge help to us. We have received our first payment from Pets at Home (£10) which will go towards our next order of food and litter. Thank you.

On behalf of all our cats and kittens can we say a huge thank you to everyone who donates to our food collection bins at the Penwortham branches of Tesco and Booths.

They continue to be a lifeline for us. Thank you.
