Cats Homed

So far this year we have homed 19 cats including 4 kittens Sooty, Sweep, Nala and Mabel. Mabel came to us from a large TNR (Trap, neuter and return) project we have been undertaking in central Preston, where with the help of local residents, we have been able to trap and neuter 18 feral cats. However, we realised that Mabel, who was approximately 10 weeks old when trapped, was a friendly little girl who would be suitable to be rehomed. When she was with us she loved to snuggle down in her comfy bed.





Over the last few months we have had a large increase in the number of requests to rehome multiple cats. Whilst we do our best to help, it is proving difficult to find homes where the cats can go together. We have recently been able to rehome two sets of cats. Siblings Harry and Tom, who came into our care following the death of their owner, have gone together to a new home in South Ribble and Mother and daughter Ruby and Pearl have also gone to their new home. Unfortunately, Ruby and Pearl came in with two other cats Diamond and Shadow who are still waiting for their new home. We have had some lovely cats in our care recently. Super friendly and very loving. They really were a delight to foster. Thankfully we have been able to find homes for these wonderful cats.

Darwen, Millie, Flo and Storm (a white and black) have also all found their loving forever homes together with our timid boy Murphy who was adopted on New Year's Day. This was fantastic start to the year.





Finally, our fabulous tabbies Tolkien and Tolstoy have also moved to their new homes. We wish them and all our other newly homed cats and their new families a long and happy time together.

Isobelle's pen has Sassy and Jess in at the moment. Sassy is a delicate 4 year-old tortie girl and Jess is a tiny white and black girl aged 2.

Lucy's pen is with Louise and the current resident is Smudge, a super affectionate big black boy. We don't know where the name Smudge came from, as he doesn't appear to have a smudge.

Victor was a stray in Preston for a while as we tried to trace his owners. He was chipped but the details were not up to date. He is a handsome 3year-old tabby and white boy.

Shadrack's pen is with Emma and home to pretty 18 month old tabby and white girl with the lovely name of Tulip.

Beck's pen is with Cheryll and her family. They are currently fostering a mum and her four kittens that were born in our care on Valentine's Day.

Scanning

For anyone that may be feeding a stray cat (or trying their best not to feed it as you think the cat may have a home), please feel free to get in touch as we have several volunteers who have micro-chip scanners who may be able to come out to scan the cat. Please consider how great it would be to re-unite the cat with its owner, especially if he or she has been missing for weeks, months or even years. Cats cannot tell us where they have been or how they came to be outside your home. I have heard people say the cat has left home for a reason, it has been abandoned, the owners don't deserve the cat, all sorts of supposition. In many cases, we just don't know, but if the cat is chipped, we can get a long way down the line to finding out some history and hopefully re-uniting he or she with their family.



Pets at home have included A Purrfect Friend on their lifelines scheme. It's huge for us, the scheme is very generous to charities. If you would like or already have nominated a charity for the lifelines scheme, you can now change your affiliation to A Purrfect Friend. To do it, go on the PAH website, select Your lifelines and the option should come up to support a local or a national charity. Click on local. Our charity is listed under the Preston Store, so if your card is registered to any other PAH, for example Capital Centre, please change that to Preston and you will see our charity at the top of the drop down list. It will now make any difference to yourself which your local store is down as, but it will be a huge help to us. We have received our first payment from Pets at Home (£10) which will go towards our next order of food and litter. Thank you.

On behalf of all our cats and kittens can we say a huge thank you to everyone who donates to our food collection bins at the Penwortham branches of Tesco and Booths.

They continue to be a lifeline for us. Thank you.
