Following a few quiet months, we have had a wonderful late summer with an amazing 20 Cats and kittens being adopted.

But the best news of all is that all our longest stay cat Doug has now found a permanent home. It is so sad that three-year old Doug, who came into our care last October, has had to spend such a long time of his young life in a pen but that's behind him now and he's the rest of his life to spend in a

loving home.



It is always more difficult to home cats in pairs rather than singularly and if cats come in together and are obviously bonded then we try our best to keep them together. We managed to successfully home three pairs of bonded cats. Jess and Sassy, Shadow and Diamond and the beautiful grey brothers Bob and Bert







We've also homed Roman and her kitten Sienna. Even though she had a lovely, comfy bed Sienna preferred to sit in the dustpan.

The other adult cats who found new homes were Robbie, Martha, Kali and Ninja.

Kitten season is in full swing once again. It never seems to go away. We have successfully found homes for 7 kittens from two litters, although we do still have both of their Mums available for adoption. The Viking clan Ragnar, Rollo, Flooki, Siggy and Torvi have all now gone to their new homes.

Sponsorship and Pen News

We have a new pen available for sponsorship. This is Mr D'Arcy's pen in honour of a beautiful cat that sadly died last month. He hadn't been in good health for a while and his owner is devastated as all who knew him are. Mr D'Arcy's pen is with Deborah along with Marybeth and Marybeth 1 pens. Deborah has had a really busy few weeks, (well that's a permanent situation at the moment) She has been looking after Imogen and her 4 kittens, Athena and her 2 kittens, Gorgeous George, Hopscotch and Marbles and Sherlock in the last couple of months. We have found homes for the 6 kittens and Imogen, Athena and Gorgeous George are currently up for adoption.

The other pens available for sponsorship are Isobelles' pen, Alfie's pen, Isobelles' pen, Lucys' pen, Shadracks' pen, Becks pen, Marybeth and Marybeth1 pens. For a minimum of £5 a month, you will receive updates and pictures of cats housed in your sponsored pen, a tag on the pen to show your sponsorship, a bi-monthly (once every two months) newsletter, and a special little gift.

Alfie's and Isobelle's pens are at Shirley's house. Alfies pen is currently home to Melissa and Rosie and her 5 kittens are in Isobelle's pen.

Lucy's's pen is home to Dottie who gave birth to 8 kittens (now 7 as sadly one didn't make it) who were 4 weeks old and undernourished when they came to us. They are all black, it's going to be hilarious homing them when they are ready. How can you choose?

Shadrack's pen is with Emma was home to our longest stay cat, Doug. We were ecstatic when a home came up for him. He was in our care for 10 and a half months.

Pringles pen is with Janice and is the current home of our longest stay cat, Banjo. Banjo is a wonderful lap cat and he doesn't mind other cats.

Beck's pen is with Cheryll and her family. They are currently fostering Nala and her two kittens who are now ready for homing.

Shadracks pen is home to another mum and her 4 kittens.

As I said, the last couple of months have been trying for all the fosterers. At one point we had 7 nursing mums and 28 kittens. We have homed 6 of the kittens, we have 2 ready now, another 7 next week and 9 the week after. We took in another cat that gave birth 4 kittens all stillborn. She has now been spayed and will be up for adoption next week. We will ensure that no cat that comes into our care will be responsible for more kittens in the future.

Thank you to all our pen sponsors, regular incomes are great, as well as the fantastic donations of food, litter and toys for our cats. I can't begin to name everyone who donates to us, but Emma's friend Jane donated enough food to feed mum and 4 kittens for a month! We appreciate that not everyone is able to do that, but even one pouch of food in one of our food collection bins is very welcome.


August/September 2023

Scanning

For anyone that may be feeding a stray cat (or trying their best not to feed it as you think the cat may have a home), please feel free to get in touch as we have several volunteers who have micro-chip scanners who may be able to come out to scan the cat. Please consider how great it would be to re-unite the cat with its owner, especially if he or she has been missing for weeks, months or even years. Cats cannot tell us where they have been or how they came to be outside your home. I have heard people say the cat has left home for a reason, it has been abandoned, the owners don't deserve the cat, all sorts of supposition. In many cases, we just don't know, but if the cat is chipped, we can get a long way down the line to finding out some history and hopefully re-uniting he or she with their family.



Pets at home have included A Purrfect Friend on their lifelines scheme. It's huge for us, the scheme is very generous to charities. If you would like or already have nominated a charity for the lifelines scheme, you can now change your affiliation to A Purrfect Friend. To do it, go on the PAH website, select Your lifelines and the option should come up to support a local or a national charity. Click on local. Our charity is listed under the Preston Store, so if your card is registered to any other PAH, for example Capital Centre, please change that to Preston and you will see our charity at the top of the drop down list. It will now make any difference to yourself which your local store is down as, but it will be a huge help to us. We have received our first payment from Pets at Home (£10) which will go towards our next order of food and litter. Thank you.

On behalf of all our cats and kittens can we say a **huge thank you** to everyone who donates to our food collection bins at the Penwortham branches of Tesco and Booths.
