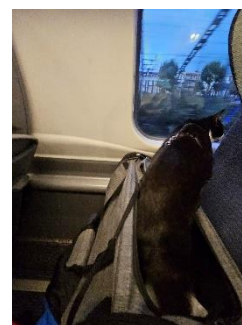

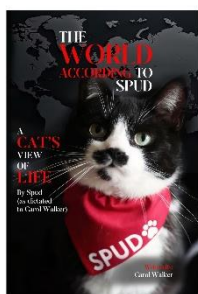
the moment as it hasn't come out yet but it is for a well known name. I also had a VERY exciting shoot in September, I had to go all the way to London!



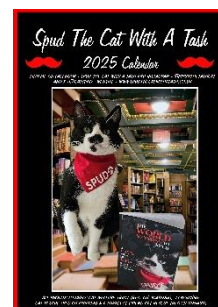
