Welcome to our first newsletter of 2025.

We started this charity in July 2020 and I am amazed how quickly the time has gone.

I wish I could name everyone who has contributed to our success, but the list is literally endless! I can only say thank you, but I assure it is heartfelt.

2024 saw 132 cats and kittens go to new homes. We took in 2 cats who were reunited with their original owner. In addition to this we have done quite of bit of trap, neuter and return work and helped several other cats in need.

Our treasurer has provided the figures for the last 6 months/12 months as below.

The work goes on of course and we are certainly not letting up. Please continue to donate goods, food and money, attend our events, (we love to see you) and we will continue with our rescue,

A Purrfect Friend - Financial Review for 6 months to December 2024

In the 6 months to December 2024, we have continued our mission to rehome our feline friends in the Preston area. We have so far homed 69 cats and raised £25k in revenue as detailed below. However, our costs have risen substantially with veterinary fees in the last 6 months already reaching the amount we spent in the whole year to June 2024. This is due to the general increase in vet fees and also the costs generated from increased trap/neuter/release activities which we are carrying out. The average cost per cat homed has increased from £264 to £393 but we continue to hold the adoption fee at £60.

Sponsorship and Pen News

In total we have 15 foster spaces.

We have 8 pens, 4 spaces at Myerscough and 3 other fosterers. Shadrack's pen, Pringle's pen, Marybeth and Marybeth 1 are all at Deborah's. Violet, Cassie, Ruby and George all have new homes but Pickle and Cheese are still waiting. A new cat in Deborah's pens is lovely Omelette. Deborah has a space as we speak, but we have new cats coming in this week.

Dotty, Pio and Ella and Chunky all have new homes and Trinity has homed Rose and Rose is her last foster cat.

Gorgeous Jackson has had cystitis and although he has had many tests done at the vets, we can't seem to get it under control, so he is still in Alfie's pen at Shirley's. We have Bean, Joey and Bellatrix in Isabelle's pen. Bean is ready for a new home, the other two will be ready very soon.

Jackie was fostering Lianna and Arya who have gone to a new home and their space is now occupied by the gorgeous Ozzy.

Lucy's pen with Louise was home to a beautiful Manx cat called George, but he wasn't with us very long before going to a new home. Sadly Sansa, who we homed last year, has had to come back into our care due to her owner having serious health issues. Sansa is a lovely cat.

Steven's pen with Cheryll had 5 playful little monkeys (there were 6 but one little girl didn't make it) which were rescued at 3 weeks old from under the seat of a scrap car. They stayed with us until they were 12 weeks old so they could be blood tested. Cheryll gave them car names and they were really sweet.

Cathy was looking after Tuna and her two kittens, Doughnut and Dazzle and Spangle. They have all gone to new homes and she now has a bonded pair of kittens, Bean and Cherry.

Those of you who so kindly sponsor our pens. As well as having all these cats in care, (and more than are mentioned here) we have also been trapping. It's been a very busy year and 2025 is set to be just as busy. We go through lots of food and litter and all our cats are health checked and have all the treatment they need to give them the best we possibly can before they leave us.

Trinity

Trinity has fostered for us for over 12 months and looked after Hopscotch, Marbles, Shaka, Victoria and Rose. She has done an amazing job, and we are very sorry to lose her. Thank you, Trinity, we will miss you.

Trap, Neuter and Return

Did you know that as well as our work rehoming stray and abandoned cats, A Purrfect Friend also helps TNR (trap, neuter and return) feral cats? This is a major part of our charities work.

If one stray or abandoned cat gives birth on the streets and the kittens grow up without being neutered in less than twelve months a colony can easily grow to between 20 and 30 cats and will keep growing until either disease or starvation takes its toll. Cats can become fertile as early as 5 months of age.

We are currently trapping at two industrial sites in East Preston. So far this year we have been trapping at 9 different locations and have neutered 76 feral cats and we have other requests for our help currently on a waiting list.

Not only is trapping costly to the charity in monetary terms, it is also time consuming for our trapping team, requiring numerous visits to our trapping sites which are often in remote areas.

Unfortunately, A Purrfect Friend is unable to help with the relocation of our feral friends

.Scanning

For anyone that may be feeding a stray cat (or trying their best not to feed it as you think the cat may have a home), please feel free to get in touch as we have several volunteers who have micro-chip scanners who may be able to come out to scan the cat. Please consider how great it would be to re-unite the cat with its owner, especially if he or she has been missing for weeks, months or even years. Cats cannot tell us where they have been or how they came to be outside your home. I have heard people say the cat has left home for a reason, it has been abandoned, the owners don't deserve the cat, all sorts of supposition. In many cases, we just don't know, but if the cat is chipped, we can get a long way down the line to finding out some history and hopefully re-uniting he or she with their family.



Pets at home have included A Purrfect Friend on their lifelines scheme. It's huge for us, the scheme is very generous to charities. If you would like or already have nominated a charity for the lifelines scheme, you can now change your affiliation to A Purrfect Friend. To do it, go on the PAH website, select Your lifelines and the option should come up to support a local or a national charity. Click on local. Our charity is listed under the Preston Store, so if your card is registered to any other PAH, for example Capital Centre, please change that to Preston and you will see our charity at the top of the drop down list. It will now make any difference to yourself which your local store is down as, but it will be a huge help to us. We have received our first payment from Pets at Home (£10) which will go towards our next order of food and litter. Thank you.

On behalf of all our cats and kittens can we say a **huge thank you** to everyone who donates to our food collection bins at the Penwortham branches of Tesco and Booths.

They continue to be a lifeline for us. Thank you.
