Sponsorship and Pen News

We now have 15 foster spaces.

This is made up of 9 pens, 4 spaces at Myerscough and 2 indoor fosterers.

The fours pens at Deborah's are Shadrack's, Pringle's, Marybeth and Marybeth 1. Daisy, Cheese and Pickle, Fudge, Pearl and Jam have all been homed and Jasmine gave birth to 4 kittens who are all ready for homing now. She also has a tabby girl with 4 kittens who was found in a yard behind a shop on Blackpool Road in Preston. The kittens were only 12 hours old when we picked them up. In her other pen is another mum and her 3 kittens. Sadly, the kittens were quite poorly when they came in but are doing really well now.

At Shirley's, in Alfie's pen and Isabelle's pen we have 3 cats in desperate need of outdoor homes. There is Jackson who has been in care for 9 months now, Bellatrix and Minnie. All are beautiful cats, very friendly but have toileting issues. We can help with relocating the cats and we do not ask for an adoption fee.

Lucy's pen with Louise was home to Bonnie and Molly who were reserved and have gone to live with a new family. Soon, their space was filled with black and white Snuggles and her 6 kittens. They, too, are looking for new homes.

We're incredibly proud to work alongside A Purrfect Friend 🐾 — a dedicated, registered cat rescue charity based right here in Preston -

Their mission? To relieve the suffering of stray and abandoned cats 🐱 in our community by providing food [m], shelter [m], veterinary care $\mathbb{Q}_{\mathbb{Q}}$, and ultimately, loving forever homes .

Leading this incredible team is Shirley (pictured here with a kitten!) who has been a champion for cats in need for over 30 years. She's supported by a devoted crew of fosterers and fundraisers who give their all to help local cats .

Recently, Shirley has been working tirelessly with TNR (Trap, Neuter, Release) 🛼 🎌 — humanely trapping feral cats to get them neutered and ear-tipped (a visual to show they've been neutered). TNR helps control the cat population, prevents disease \times , and protects the wellbeing of cats in the wild &.

With so many cats needing help lately, our amazing team — Mandy, Ayesha, and Beki — volunteered their own time on a Sunday morning 🔆 to run a special neutering clinic. Even better? They chose not to claim overtime, allowing us to offer even bigger discounts on each procedure 🐾 💷 .

The result? A neutering session not affecting the day to day running of our busy clinic, more cats helped — and yes, Shirley brought cake 📤 to make the day even sweeter!









Trap, Neuter and Return

Did you know that as well as our work rehoming stray and abandoned cats, A Purrfect Friend also helps TNR (trap, neuter and return) feral cats? This is a major part of our charities work.

If one stray or abandoned cat gives birth on the streets and the kittens grow up without being neutered in less than twelve months a colony can easily grow to between 20 and 30 cats and will keep growing until either disease or starvation takes its toll. Cats can become fertile as early as 5 months of age.

Not only is trapping costly to the charity in monetary terms, it is also time consuming for our trapping team, requiring numerous visits to our trapping sites which are often in remote areas.

Unfortunately, A Purrfect Friend is unable to help with the relocation of our feral friends

For anyone that may be feeding a stray cat (or trying their best not to feed it as you think the cat may have a home), please feel free to get in touch as we have several volunteers who have micro-chip scanners who may be able to come out to scan the cat. Please consider how great it would be to re-unite the cat with its owner, especially if he or she has been missing for weeks, months or even years. Cats cannot tell us where they have been or how they came to be outside your home. I have heard people say the cat has left home for a reason, it has been abandoned, the owners don't deserve the cat, all sorts of supposition. In many cases, we just don't know, but if the cat is chipped, we can get a long way down the line to finding out some history and hopefully re-uniting he or she with their family.



Pets at home have included A Purrfect Friend on their lifelines scheme. It's huge for us, the scheme is very generous to charities. If you would like or already have nominated a charity for the lifelines scheme, you can now change your affiliation to A Purrfect Friend. To do it, go on the PAH website, select Your lifelines and the option should come up to support a local or a national charity. Click on local. Our charity is listed under the Preston Store, so if your card is registered to any other PAH, for example Capital Centre, please change that to Preston and you will see our charity at the top of the drop down list. It will now make any difference to yourself which your local store is down as, but it will be a huge help to us. We have received our first payment from Pets at Home (£10) which will go towards our next order of food and litter. Thank you.

On behalf of all our cats and kittens can we say a **huge thank you** To everyone who donates to our food collection bins at the Penwortham branches of Tesco and Booths.
